

## 6/3/10 Session Highlights:

- Celebration of Baptisms: Claire Mayben on May 16, 2010  
Celebration of New Members: Lanna Mayben on May 16, 2010  
Celebration of Life: Rachel Hamilton to be with our Lord and Savior on May 20, 2010
- Representing Youth Ministry: Guest, Tucker Stovall, presented a verbal summary of the financial report from the youth ski trip in March 2010. In consensus, Session declined the youth program from having a separate bank account.
- Tucker Stovall stated that the current youth leaders are open to having other volunteers assist in the youth programming and informed that Jody and Steve Heeg will begin as regular youth volunteer leaders in the fall.
- Session discussed the possibility of the youth program having a three year cycle of trips: 1) ski or fun trip one year 2) mission or service trip (not including Goodland) one year and 3) a camp or conference program sponsored by PC (USA) leadership one year.
- Building and Property Ministry: Ed is still waiting for information from the building's original architect to give a detailed report dealing with building problems and potential problems (particularly water flooding) related to the building. Ed will forward the report once he has a copy. The church electronic sign problem continues to be investigated.
- Personnel Ministry made a motion to provide the music director, Tom Bozarth a \$10.00 per service raise to be effective beginning June 1, 2010. The motion passed.
- Personnel Ministry made a motion to pay Pastor Amy Hunt a love offering. The motion carried.
- Session (via personnel and the Session – KDO representative, Sue Watson) has made a formal request that an annual review be made on the Director of the KDO. Session does not need the results of the review; however, it would like to have a report when the review has been accomplished.
- KDO will be giving Session a copy of the KDO Board meeting minutes on a regular basis.
- Elementary and Youth: Faith Development Ministry made a motion to approve the teaching of the PC(USA) curriculum, Sexuality: God's Gift to:
  - 4<sup>th</sup> & 5<sup>th</sup> grades with Amy Guest and Brian Johnson teaching;
  - Middle school youth with David and M-J Junkin teaching; and
  - High School youth with Lance and Kathy Garms teaching on Sunday afternoons for eight to ten weeks beginning sometime in September. The motion carried.

- A young adult Sunday school class will begin June 6, 2010.
- Mission and Outreach: Preparations for the Summer Lunch program is underway. D'Ann Kleinman has generously volunteered to serve as our coordinator for this year.
- Presbytery Report: Amy Hunt will attend the June 12, 2010 Presbytery meeting with no Session representative from Faithbridge.
- Information Technology: Currently there is a desktop computer in the pastor's office for Chris Carson to use.
- The church currently has three to four computers and backup. There are two membership/congregation lists: one on ACS the other is on an email list.
- Nominating Committee: Betty Smith expressed concern on behalf of the Diaconate that there is a position opening in their board. Also, there are several openings on the nominating committee at present. After discussion, Meg Reichard made a motion to "not fill any unexpired position for the nominating committee or the diaconate until the usual Fall elections. Ben Carter seconded. The motion passed.
- Amy Hunt will be away June 13 - 18, 2010. A worship recognition followed by a church wide luncheon for her ministry and service to Faithbridge will be held on Sunday, June 27, 2010.
